DOGS IN CARS

Remedial action will be taken in the event of dogs left in cars being found in a distressed condition.

Unlike us, dogs do not sweat through their skins, they lose excess heat by panting. If their temperature exceeds 95f (35c) they cannot lose any more heat by panting and their temperature rises, leading to heat stroke.

This can happen if a dog is left in a car on a sunny day. It need not even be a hot day and the windows may be partly open, but the dog can over heat.

Emergency treatment may be required to cool the dog down. If you find a collapsed animal and hot to touch, he should be cooled immediately by soaking with cold water.

Dogs which have won any of the following awards are not eligible for entry at this show:-

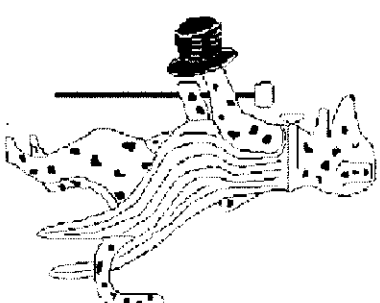
